Greenwich Yacht Club, was originally founded by Thames Watermen in 1908, and has had a significant presence on the Thames for over a hundred years. The club set out to provide affordable boating for all, and has expanded its activities over the years with regular dinghy sailing and rowing in its two historic cutters.

Racing and cruising are at the heart of a sailing club. Some members like to compete in as many races as possible, and some like to cruise further afield. Individual and team achievements are rewarded and celebrated by the whole club in the annual Prize Giving ceremony, with some splendid trophies.

Over the years our trophy awards have been recorded in the all-important "red book" securely kept in the club safe. 
