I. Introduction

Greenwich Yacht Club, was originally founded by Thames Watermen in 1908, and has had a significant presence on the Thames for over a hundred years. The club set out to provide affordable boating for all and has expanded its activities over the years with regular sailing and rowing in its two historic cutters.

Racing and cruising are at the heart of a sailing club. Some members like to compete in as many races as possible, and some like to cruise further afield. Individual and team achievements are rewarded and celebrated by the whole club in the annual Prize Giving ceremony, with some splendid trophies.

Over the years our trophy awards have been recorded in the all-important "red book" securely kept in the club safe. When I was appointed as the first Marketing & Communications officer in 2019, I made it part of my mission to digitise the club's history and make the information public. Digitising the club's trophies and securely storing all the information in what has become known as our trophy bible was vital.

New cups and shields have been added to our trophy cabinet over the years. Some have been presented by other clubs and business or personal sponsors. Over time retiring Commodores have also added their own awards. This detailed record of all our awards over the years presents a fascinating account of our history, and a lasting tribute to the intrepid achievements of Greenwich Yacht Club members.

We are a proud club with important history on our river. I'm confident that celebrating the achievements of our sailors by sharing our history in this way, will not only sustain our vibrant legacy for all time, but promote our wonderful club to the world beyond our gates.

Special thanks go to all these members (e.g. commodores and committee members past and present) who have helped complete the history of these trophies and editing –Stephen (Steve) Wilson, Michael (Mike) Wood, Jim Four, Ian Palmer, Stan Payne and Lionel Willis.

There are not many trophies awarded in 2020 due to the covid pandemic and lockdown. I am hugely grateful to both Lionel Willis and Steve Wilson who have been fact-checking this document since the beginning of this project. The next version of the Trophy document we will add more information about the Trophies.

II. Key layout

This document is laid out as follows.

- Boat names are in capital letters and italics.
- This document is an amalgamation of many spreadsheets from ex-commodores to cruiser captains therefore "Not Run", "cancelled", "abandoned" or "not awarded" have all been replaced with "Not Run" in italics and bold. If known, the reason is added to the comments e.g. no wind.
- Names are written in full, what they were called by some folks in brackets e.g. "Stephen (Steve) Wilson".
- All missing years where we have no information has been highlighted in yellow.
- Trophy headings are "Header1 Font", left aligned.
- Chapter headings are "Title Font", centred
- Body of document is "Ariel 11 Font"
- This is the GYC Trophy document. Therefore, I want to record every trophy, even 1-off trophies. If there will be more 1-off trophies in the future we can put them all together in their own chapter.

III. Process before "Dinner/Dance"

This is a new section we added that I thought is important for future members to know the 'Trophy process', so that when we retire it can be taken on by future members in a seamless way. Plus, it would be good for current members to know the trophy process that goes on behind the scenes, before everything comes together at the Annual Dinner Dance.

When the Commodore receives the full list of winners from the captains and nominations for trophies. This is collated and sent to Stephen Wilson. Stephen, Preeda and sometimes accompanied by Lionel – starts to prepare the trophies: -

- 1. Trophies the winners won, are located in the trophy cabinet.
- 2. Their base is removed.
- 3. The name of the winner of that trophy is written on a label and stuck on the base for the engraver to engrave.
- 4. The labelled bases in a box for Stephen to take to the engraver.
- 5. Stephen Wilson then drives the box of bases to "Engrave-a-gift", 266 Broadway, Bexleyheath DA6 8BE (Paul Covington); sales @engraveagift.co.uk; 020 8298 7575
 - a. "Engrave-a-gift" engrave the bases of the trophies with the name of the winner on the label.
 - b. "Engrave-a-gift" they also engrave wine glasses for the female winners and engraved tumblers for the male winners. These are the gifts the winners receive instead of the trophy the name of the trophy, the winners name and the year is engraved on the gifts.
 - c. After a week Stephen goes back to the engrave-a-gift to collect all the engraved bases.
 - d. Bases are connected to their trophies.
- 6. Preeda will make a typed list of the winners and their trophies. This list is compared to the actual list of folks coming to the Dinner Dance which is given by the Willo Project and they are highlighted on the document.
- 7. The highlighted list is given to the commodore and a copy is left by the trophy so the winners who are at the Dinner/Dance are the only ones the commodore will read out. They will receive their trophies.
- 8. Trophies of the winners who will be attending the dinner/dance are the only ones that needs to be polish.
- 9. After polishing the Trophies, the trophies and the gifts for the winners are displayed at the dinner/dance table ready for the Commodore to present them to the winners at the event.
- 10. After the event the trophies are taken back to the trophy cabinet for safe keeping for another year.


